Council has considered and refused an application to increase the amount of non-putrescible waste received at the Minda Landfill at 2622 Oallen Ford Road, Windellama.

The modification application was refused on a number of grounds, including:

- The proposal represents an unacceptable intensification of the present use and may adversely impact on the environmental value of the site and locality,
- The proposal would have an adverse affect on the amenity of the area,
- The development is undesirable in terms of the impacts caused by the proposal on the road network, and
- The proposal is undesirable in terms of the level of concern expressed by residents.


