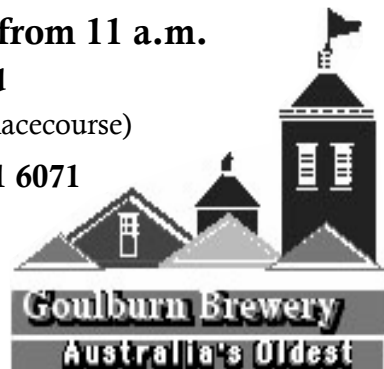

These awards were presented to members who have volunteered over many years both in the field and support roles.

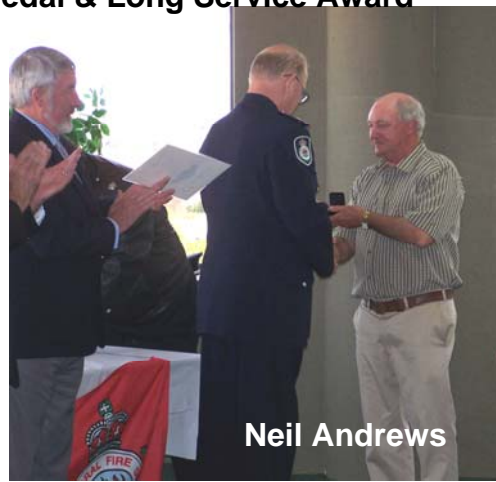
In addition to the Long Service Award the Captain Lynton Roberts received the National Service Medal.

**No Ear Tag - No Sale!**

Under legislation governing the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) for sheep and goats, all sheep / goats born after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2006 **MUST** be identified with an approved ear tag before they are sent to the saleyards: **no ear tag – no sale!**

Approved ear tags can be purchased from the Rural Lands Protection Board or local farm supply companies and will be embossed with the Property Identification Code (PIC) number of the property of birth and the NLIS logo. Alternatively, producers may use pink, post breeder (“emergency”) ear tags which can be purchased from the RLPB.

Producers are urged to contact Animal Health Rangers; Scott Craig or Gary Poile at the **Goulburn RLPB on 4821 2522** should they have any questions regarding ear tag compliance.

## Lavender Farm Open Day to help Leukaemia Foundation

On Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2006 from 10am to 3pm at 'Mooroowoolen' Marulan, will hold a Lavender Open Day to raise funds for the Leukaemia Foundation.



There will be over 26,000 plants in bloom on display, and in addition there will be an exhibition garden featuring 45 different varieties of lavender. Also under cover there will be demonstrations of the methods of bunching and drying lavender, harvesting and distillation of lavender oil.

Recently at The Lavender Growers' Association (TALGA) International Conference Mooroooolen' was awarded 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes for the fragrance of

its oils. A number of 'Mooroooolen' lavender products will be available for purchase, including the prize winning oils, 'Lavender Mist', 'Lavender Mud', and 'Lavender Body Butter', just to name a few.

The Open Day will also offer a wonderful opportunity to experience life on a farm situated on 1100 acres. Children will enjoy meeting Stuart the Great, Snowy the Pony, Daisy the pet ewe with her twin lambs, and the pigs Kirsty and Kate.

The day will be the first time this prize winning lavender farm has been open to the public. Refreshments and barbeque will be available and provided by Marulan Lions Club and the Marulan Bush Fire Brigade will assist with parking arrangements.

The entry fee for the day will be a donation – dig deep, it is for a great cause.  
(Unfortunately NO credit card or eftpos facilities)

As a souvenir of this special day there will be a 'Mooroooolen' lavender gift.

'Mooroooolen' address is 16323 Hume Highway, Marulan – it has direct access from the Highway between Goulburn and Marulan. It is 6.8 kms south of Marulan on the left hand side; and 21 kms north of Goulburn on the right hand side. When traveling north it is safer to pass 'Mooroooolen' and turn at the top of the hill.

Just look out for the signs and lavender coloured balloons.
