100 ideas for 100 acres – I only have a few acres, what can I do?



Out of area fire

The Brigade has already assisted a neighbouring Brigade at the beginning of the fire season for two days because of lightning.

Bush Fire Danger Period

The Statutory Bushfire Danger Period applies throughout the Southern Tablelands Zone form 1st October to 31st March each year **unless** revoked by the Responsible Authority due to variations in climatic conditions. Notice of any variation of the Danger Period will be published in at least one local newspaper.

DURING BUSHFIRE DANGER PERIODS, THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

ARE TO BE OBSERVED:

FUEL REDUCTION, CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE BREAKS, CLEARING ETC - BY BURNING

- (a) A permit to light, use or maintain a fire issued subject to the provisions of the Rural Fires Act, 1997 must be obtained in writing from the local Rural Fire Brigade Captain, **in whose area the fire is to be lit.** Inspection of the proposed burn area will be carried out by the Brigade Captain **prior** to the permit being issued.
 - Permits within the NSW FB Districts of Goulburn, Yass and Crookwell can be obtained from the Fire Stations in those locations.
- (b) Notice must be given **24 hours before the fire is lit** all adjoining **landholders**, **Brigade Captain** and **Firecom**.
- (c) At least one person shall be present at the site of the fire from the time it is lit until such time it is extinguished.
- (d) Duration of a permit is at the discretion of the Permit Issuing Officer (Brigade Captain). A permit may be revoked, suspended or varied by the Permit Officer, particularly if weather conditions deteriorate to such a level which is, in the opinion of the officer, conducent to the outbreak and spread of fire.

If a TOTAL FIRE BAN (TOBAN) is proclaimed during this time, the permit is automatically cancelled and must be applied for again following the expiry of the TOBAN.

Remember lighting strikes cause many problems in our area, so once again please be on the lookout for smoke rising after the storm has passed. Fire can still start days after the storm.

When a total fire ban is issued there are precautions that must be taken particularly when working outside, and if possible many tasks such as working with welding equipment, slashers etc. should be put off. Care is required when using **all** forms of **mowers** during the Bushfire Danger Period.

Training

The Brigade will be running and Accredited Basic Firefighting course on the 24th and 25th November.




