Keep alert on our local roads - always expect the unexpected.

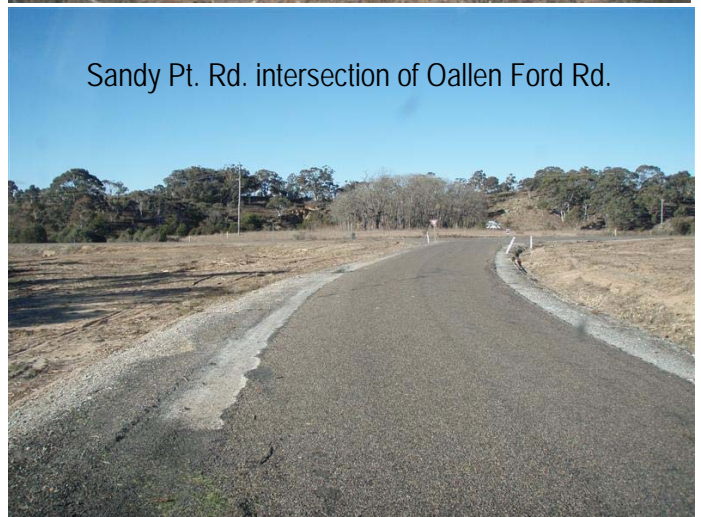
A motorist recently was very lucky indeed to survive after this accident. **Thank You** to community members, Windellama SES First Aiders and Windellama RFB who assisted the driver.

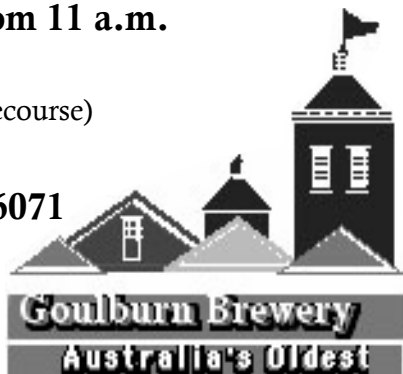

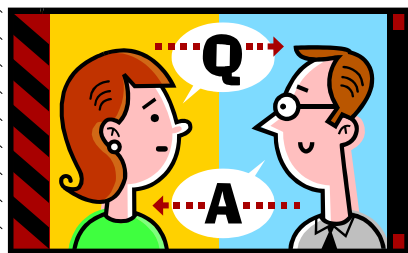

Windellama SES First Aid

Over the last month or two it has been brought to my attention that not many people in the community know that we have a community first aid response unit in the area.

The Windellama SES First Aid is a first response unit to the Ambulance Service.

When a call is put through to the Ambulance Service from an area where travel, distance and response time are critical factors, the nearest CFR unit is activated to provide assistance until the ambulance arrives.

In Windellama we are lucky to have our own unit, which also covers a large area; we go north to Bungonia, as far down as Nerriga and then over to Tarago.

In the last month we have responded to two incidents – one in Windellama and one in Nerriga. If you need assistance you can call 4844 5506 or 4844 7143

We will be at the Fire Brigade open day, so come along and say g'day.

On the SES side we are waiting on the paper work to happen before we can proceed with the shed.

BUNGONIA - Bungonia Hall
TARAGO - Tarago Hall

Please remember: Voting is compulsory. The penalty for not voting in local government elections is \$55.00. Voting is not compulsory for enrolled non-residential electors except those enrolled on the Council of the City of Sydney roll.

Voting before the election

Will you be away for this election? Have you changed address recently and didn't update your enrolment details before close of rolls on

4 August? As there is no absentee voting at local council elections, you can either vote by post or at your local pre-poll voting centre.

Apply to vote by post before 5pm 8 September

Postal votes

You may apply for a postal vote if you cannot attend a polling place in your area/ward on election day between 8 am and 6 pm for any of the following reasons. You:

- will not be in your ward/council area
- will not be within 8 km of any polling place
- will be travelling under conditions which will prevent attending a polling place
- are seriously ill or disabled and cannot attend a polling place
- are prevented by approaching maternity from attending a polling place
- are a member of a religious order or have religious beliefs which prevent you from attending a polling place or voting during polling hours
- are in a correctional centre and are precluded from attending a polling place
- are at a place other than a hospital, caring for a person who needs care for medical reasons and will be prevented from attending a polling place; or
- will be working during polling hours and are unable to attend a polling place
- are a silent elector.

Postal vote applications

You must complete a postal vote application form and submit by post or fax to your council's returning officer for receipt by not later than 5 pm on the Monday before election day. Make sure you apply early so that voting material can be sent to you before election day.

Once your application has been processed you will be sent postal vote ballot papers and a declaration envelope for their return. You must complete the ballot papers and sign and date the certificate in the presence of a witness. It can be posted to the returning officer or handed in at any polling place on election day.

At the time of an election, application forms for postal votes are available here, from your council office or from your returning officer.
